## <u>May 2012 House Tour</u>

In the last newsletter, we discussed the ease of using bulbs to landscape a home. To make life really easy, using a tiller cuts down on time and backache. Home Depot and other hardware stores rent tillers by the half or full day -- at Home Depot its \$40 for a half day + deposit on your credit card. The lightest weight tiller is a Mantis, which is also easy to use.

Most bulbs need to be planted in the fall, when the ground temperature is 40-50 degrees, and need to be 4-6" deep in the earth. The tiller can dig 6" deep, saving you time and energy. The extra earth can be shoveled on to a tarp while you arrange the bulbs, pointy tops up, and then voila -- just place the dirt back over the bulbs and wait for spring.. Other fall "spruce up" might involve trimming overgrowth on sidewalks and plants along the curb.
